With just over one week to go until the School Production, **it is essential that all children have their costume items at school, in a named bag, by Friday 2nd July and given to the classroom teacher.** There will be a full dress rehearsal on Tuesday 6th July and the costumes will remain at the venue for the Wednesday matinee performance. Children will take the costumes home with them after school on Wednesday for the evening performance (please check your child/ren does have their costume with them).

** Boys performing in the Kapa Haka Roopu need to have black shorts – please send these to school in a named bag by Friday 2nd July.

Students will be travelling by bus to the City West Church on Tuesday 6th July for the dress rehearsal, and again on Wednesday 7th July for a morning rehearsal and the matinee performance, leaving St Joseph's at 9.00am and returning at approximately 2.30pm on both days. Please ensure your children are at school by 8.50am. Parents of students with lead rolls will be contacted regarding rehearsals at the venue on Monday 5th July.

All children will need to be at the City West Church on Poplar Grove by 6.30pm on Wednesday 3rd July dressed in their costumes and with bare feet, ready for a 7.00pm start. Can we ask that parents please look after shoes, jackets, etc, as there is not enough space backstage for these items.

The children will be on stage for the entire performance which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes; you should all be home by 8.45pm. If picking up children, please be at the hall by 8.10pm and collect them from inside. It is expected that all children will be performing next Wednesday unless there are circumstances beyond a family's control. Please advise the classroom teacher if this is the case. Parking will be tight at the venue. Please do not park on the City West driveway.
