COVID 19 Alert Level 1 Schooling – UPDATE /REMINDER
Information for Parents, Caregivers and Children

With the recent cases in Australia and the suspension of the Trans-Tasman Travel Bubble, along with the recent waste water testing in New Plymouth, it is timely for us to remember our responsibilities for Alert Level One schooling and being prepared for Alert Level 2.

REMINDER: What St Joseph's NP School looks like at Alert Level 1.

Classrooms and Pick Up and Drop off

- Soap is available for handwashing. Hand sanitiser is also available in classrooms.
- Parents are able to access the school site and are able to visit classrooms and the office. Please be aware if there is a return to Alert Level 2 schooling, adults / parents will not be able to access the school grounds or buildings. Please make sure you are helping your children to be independent with arriving and leaving the school on their own. If we change back to Alert Level 2 schooling, children will need to be able to come up to their classroom and leave the grounds at the end of the day on their own.
- The Government QR Code will be on every classroom window / door and at the office. (Please scan the Government QR Code when you enter the first building or classroom on every visit to the school. The Track and Trace function on the school app remains active and can also be used (front screen of the App—remember to log in and log out).
- Please sign children out at the office if taking children out of the school during the day.

Managing Attendance

- Students and staff will not attend school if they are unwell. Students and staff who become unwell during the school day are required to be sent home. If people are sick, they must stay home (phone Healthline or their GP if they have flu-like symptoms). Use the App to notify the school if a student is not attending school please include a detailed reason.
- Parents who take children out during the day must sign children out at the office. Visitors will
 continue to sign in and sign out at the office and use the Government Tracing App.

Hygiene

 At Alert Level 1 we will continue to follow good hygiene practices (coughing and sneezing into elbows, sanitising, handwashing with soap and drying hands).

• OSCAR will continue to be up and running while we are at Alert Level 1. The OSCAR Programme will be using the same protocols as the school.
