I hope you and your whānau are having a great weekend and making the most of the 'bubble' time together.

For those of you who are working with the public in essential services, we cannot thank you enough and we ask for continued blessings for your own health and safety.

By now you have probably developed a daily 'bubble rhythm'. Have a think and create a bit of a schedule for the week with your children. You will need to consider your family context. Create a timetable for class teacher Zooms (see table below), time to complete learning tasks from teachers (see parent emails today / tomorrow) and time for reading, screen time, recreation and walks / bike rides and time for chill / quiet time around parent work commitments. Most importantly make sure you have time for daily prayer. Our children can lead you in what they do in the classroom each day. We will share more ideas during the week.

Teachers will connect with children via Zoom for a face to face session a couple of times a week. During the first week these sessions will be ensuring families can use Zoom and iron out any little issues. The learning that is shared for families and children will involve independent tasks and some tasks where a little guidance or shared learning with an adult may be required.

While we request that children spend some of each 'school' day completing learning tasks, we will leave the schedule and amount of time to families to decide. Just being involved in your children's play and activities will lead to curiosity, questions and natural learning. I can remember families doing all sorts of things last year, building with offcuts, searching for insects around the section, planting seeds, making cheese, cooking, astronomy and just having fun playing.

We will continue to share ideas on our Facebook Page. Search for St Joseph's Catholic School, New Plymouth and like our page. We currently have an art challenge running for children and families. We are also sharing out cool events and ideas on the page. I would recommend joining the animal quiz tomorrow afternoon. It looks like heaps of fun.
